Aufbrüche. Abbrüche. Umbrüche.

Kunst in Ost-Berlin 1985-1995

One exhibition at three locations

The exhibition and contemporary witness project can be seen from August 25th at the Stiftung Kunstforum Berliner Volksbank and from September 16th in the Nikolaikirche and Ephraim-Palais museums and ends together on December 11th, 2022.

The first part of the special exhibition will open on August 25 at the Stiftung Kunstforum Berliner Volksbank *Aufbrüche. Abbrüche. Umbrüche. Kunst in Ost-Berlin 1985-1995*. The second part will open on September 16 in the Nikolaikirche and Ephraim-Palais museums at two different locations. The exhibition is being created in close collaboration between the Stiftung Kunstforum Berliner Volksbank and the Stadtmuseum Berlin.

Under the motto: 1 topic - 2 art collections - 3 exhibition locations, selected positions by East Berlin artists from the respective in-house collections from the fields of sculpture, graphics, photography and painting on the upheaval in Berlin around 1989/90 are presented. These include, among other Annemirl Bauer, Kurt Buchwald, Manfred Butzmann, Ellen Fuhr, Christina Glanz, Dieter Goltzsche, Angela Hampel, Sabine Herrmann, Martin Hoffmann, Uta Hünniger, Klaus Killisch, Konrad Knebel, Walter Libuda, Rolf Lindemann, Harald Metzkes, Olaf Nehmzow, Sabine Peuckert, Hans Scheib, Cornelia Schleime, Maria Sewcz, Ursula Strozynski, Hans Ticha, Harald Toppl, Joachim Völkner, Veronika Wagner, Trak Wendisch and Karla Woisnitza. This insight, back into a special time in Berlin, is deepened by film interviews of some of these artists.

The exhibitions can be seen in Berlin-Charlottenburg and Berlin-Mitte until December 11, 2022. In the complementary selection of artists, the art project offers a multifaceted picture of the (East) Berlin art scene around 1990.
